






Special Fitments



Nest of three Drawers £450

Can be fitted to any sink unit or cabinet, situated in cupboard under standard top drawer. Accessible through cupboard door, which maintains uniform styling. Used for vegetable storing or ordinary drawer storage. Aluminium, finished cabinet colour.



Wall Cupboard Corner Supports £300

Consisting of four metal brackets, which bolted to adjoining wall cupboards, support cupboard across corner.



Coloured Wire Basket Fitment £4O

For dusters, cloths etc. Colours to match units. Fits to the inside of the cabinet.



Soap Container Fitment £45

Chromium plated soap holder for attachment to back ledge of sink unit.




Mixer Tap Swivel Nozzle £12O

The "English Rose" kitchen was the first "styled" kitchen to be produced, providing the natural progressive development of equipment for the most important room in the house.

"English Rose" sink units and floor cabinets are constructed from 'Pyluminised' aluminium, mounted on a 3" stainless steel base, with highly polished stainless steel sinks, drainers and work tops—materials specially chosen for their resistance to the humid conditions in the kitchen. They are available in most RAL colours. As an alternative to stainless steel they can be supplied with colourful "Softglow" Formica work tops.
